Background

Cost sharing/matching represents the portion of a grant award's total costs that are not provided by the sponsor of the award. It is the partial support for the cost of a sponsored award provided by the University or by a third party. The terms "cost sharing" and "matching" are often used

Types of Cost Sharing

Mandatory – Project costs that are not borne by the sponsor, but are required as a condition of the award. “Sponsored encouraged” cost sharing not required as a condition of receiving an award does not

During the Award Stage:

Certifying cost sharing must be done by using the Cost Sharing/Matching Contribution form with detailed documentation attached. The form must be submitted to ORSP semi annually by the PI. All appropriate signatures must be included on the form. All cost sharing identified on the form must
