A public showing of their new work, “Don t Suck,” created and directed by Eric Kupers, assistant professor of theatre and dance, is set for 7:30 p.m. Sept. 7.

This is a segment of the larger piece, “Dance Experiments with Reality TV”

The residency grants the company \$15,000, training opportunities, and use of the Princess Grace Foundation and the Baryshnikov Arts Center to rehearse and perform the show.

Dandelion is collaborating with filmmaker Austin Forbord to do a first draft of a reality TV pilot looking at competition in experimental dance.
